General Statement

Warrington Town Netball Club (WTNC) is committed to ensure the Health, Safety and Welfare of players (senior and junior), coaches, officials, volunteers and spectators at training, events and matches.

This policy statement applied to all members of Warrington Town Netball Club.

Culture, Core values and Behavior

WTNC members are expected to:

- Take personal responsibility for the safety of themselves and fellow club members
- Comply with WTNC policies and procedures
- Always wear the correct clothing and shoes to undertake matches and training
- Report unsafe situations and events at matches and training
- Take the opportunity to learn from events and take appropriate action to prevent any recurrence

Goals and Targets

Our goal is to achieve zero accidents / incidents. All members are encouraged to achieve zero accidents / incidents and to assist other members in achieving this goal. Health and Safety will be an agenda item on all formal meetings.

Risk Assessment

All WTNC activities are assessed for risk before they commence.

Playing Area

The playing area should be checked against the WTNC Risk Assessment Form.

Organising for Health and Safety

WTNC coaches are trained to be competent in carrying out their duties. Suitable first aid, welfare and emergency procedures are in place. All equipment and materials are used, stored and transported in a safe manner. Club members under the age of 16 are supervised at all times.
